Tuna the chiweenie is one of Instagram's most famous dogs. A chiweenie is a mix between a chihuahua and a dachshund. Tuna has a very special look because of his big overbite and wrinkled neck. This unusual face made people smile, and soon his photos went viral online. Today, Tuna has around 1.9 million followers on Instagram. With so many fans, Tuna is more than just a pet. He is also a brand. Companies pay to have Tuna appear in sponsored posts. Reports say that top Instagram dogs like Tuna can make between 3,000 and 10,000 dollars for one post. The money depends on how many followers they have and how much people interact with their photos.

Tuna is not the only star. Other dogs, like Jiffpom the Pomeranian, have even more followers — over 10 million — and can earn even higher fees. These “pet influencers” work like human influencers: they promote products such as clothes, dog food, or travel. For owners, it can be a full-time job. They take professional pictures, plan posts, and answer fans. But at the same time, followers say the dogs give them daily joy and positive feelings.

Every year, birthday parties create a huge amount of rubbish. In the United States alone, it is estimated that over 500,000 balloons are used each day, many of them for birthdays. Most of these balloons cannot be recycled and take more than 100 years to break down. This is why families are now choosing waste-free celebrations. Instead of balloons, parents can use fabric bunting, paper lanterns, or even LED fairy lights that can be reused for many years. A survey in 2023 showed that families who used reusable decorations saved about 50 dollars per year. Party favors are another big source of waste. Cheap plastic toys often last only a few minutes before breaking. Studies show that more than 80% of plastic party favors end up in landfills within a week. A better option is giving each child something useful, such as homemade cookies, a cupcake box, or a small plant in a paper pot. Food is also important. Using real plates and cups instead of disposable ones can save up to 100 plastic items at a party with 20 children. Leftover cake can be shared or frozen. A waste-free party is cheaper, more creative, and much kinder to the planet.
